How to Get Your Non-Fiction Writing Published

Could your email rants be the makings of an Op Ed? Do you write non-fiction but leave it to sit in a file on your computer? Come to this session for tips on how to move your writing from your computer to the pages of magazines and newspapers.

At the conclusion of this activity, participants will be understand various options for publishing non-academic non-fiction.

- 1. Participants will identify venues for pitching non-academic non-fiction.
- 2. Participants will be able to formulate a pitch.
- 3. Participants will demonstrate an ability to distinguish an opinion piece from a reported piece.
- 4. Participants will understand the process of working with an editor once a pitch is accepted.
