What is Real?: How the History and Personalities of Quantum Mechanics Affect our Understanding of Reality

The first half of this talk will be an overview of Quantum Mechanics and why it's so difficult to interpret its results (much like the Quantum Consciousness talk at Rural and Remote 2018). The latter half will explore different interpretations of Quantum Mechanics and how personalities, politics, and historical events have impacted the debate over which of these provide a better picture of "Reality."

- 3. Participants will explore how personalities and politics can influence scientific understanding.
