Pediatric Simulation Workshop

Pediatric Emergencies: What keeps you awake at night?

Simulation based education provides a safe, open environment for practice and learning. This immersive learning experience will engage participants in the emergency care of two pediatric patients presenting with illness or injury. This session will use high technical fidelity simulators and emergency equipment to allow real time, hands-on treatment and interventions. Participants will work in teams during the 20 minute scenarios after which there will be a group debrief and discussion.

1. To review the principles of pediatric emergency care.
2. To review treatment of pediatric illness and injury in the context of two simulation scenarios.
3. To discuss the care of pediatric patients in rural and remote settings.
