## Perineal Repair

Perineal trauma is a common obstetric complication and must be considered in every vaginal delivery. Here we review the classification of lower genital tract lacerations and provide a basic overview of management both in the labour & delivery room as well as in the postpartum period. The session will begin with a presentation followed by a hands-on workshop.

- 1. Explore obstetric perineal trauma and classify perineal lacerations.
- 2. Evaluate the risk factors associated with perineal trauma.
- 3. Recognize, manage and prevent perineal lacerations.
- 4. Manage postpartum complications relating to perineal repair, including initiating appropriate referrals as indicated.
