

WHAT THE CASES SAY, AND WHAT SHOULD WE DO ABOUT IT? RURAL MATERNITY CARE PLANNING WORKSHOP

This session will be a planning workshop for participants to help inform strategic directions for education, advocacy or awareness on rural maternity care. Data provided from the CMPA will be briefly presented with the purpose of finding themes unique to rural obstetrical care, and participants will use this information to determine priority action areas for the SRPC Maternity & Newborn Care Committee.

1. Explore the issues that lead to rural maternity care medicolegal cases involving the CMPA
2. Identify potential gaps currently present in research or quality care initiatives for rural providers
3. Prioritize areas of action for future advocacy, research or educational activities by the SRPC
4. Reflect on what some of this information may mean for the participant's individual practice
